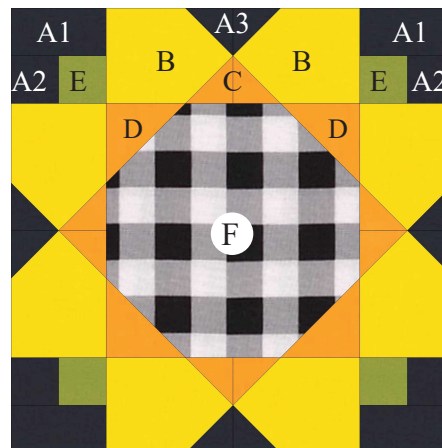

Supplies & Cutting Instructions

Color	Piece	Cutting Instructions
	A1 A2 A3	(4) 2" x 3.5" rectangles (1) 2" x 9" rectangle (4) 2" x 3.5" rectangles
	B	(8) 3.5" x 4.5" rectangles
	C D	(4) 2" x 3.5" rectangles (4) 3" squares
	E	(1) 2" x 9" rectangle
	F	(1) 8.5" square Fabric Provided
Borders (optional)		(2) 2.5" x 14.5" rectangles (2) 2.5" x 18.5" rectangles

- Please read all instructions before beginning.
- All seam allowances are 1/4"
- RST = right sides together

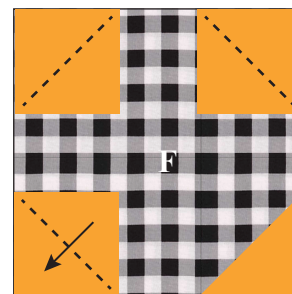


Make yourself a sunflower that will never fade away! This easy block has some sneaky piecing that eliminates extra seams.

Block Instructions

Center Unit

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 3" D square.
2. Place a marked D square RST on one corner of the 8.5" F square. Stitch on the marked line.
3. Trim seam allowance and press towards the corners.
4. Repeat steps 2-3 for the remaining corners to create the center square unit.

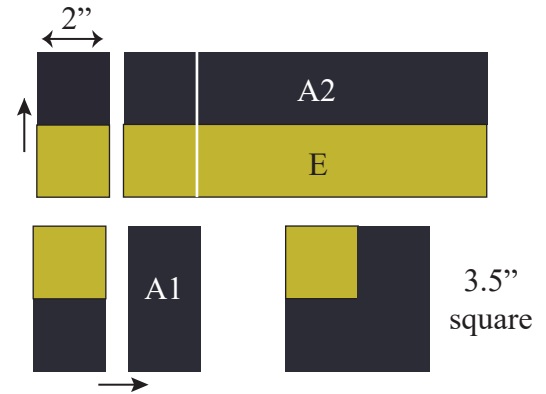

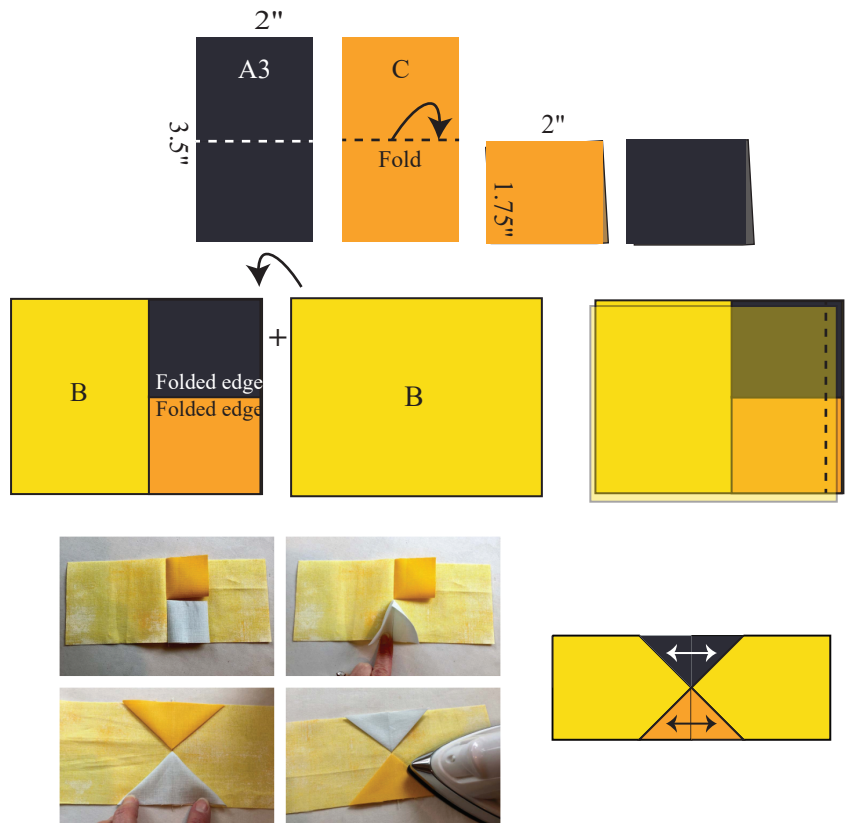
Leaf Units

5. With RST, sew a 2" x 9" A2 rectangle to a 2" x 9" E rectangle. Press towards the darker fabric.
6. Cut A2/E strip into (4) 2" wide segments.
7. Sew a 2" x 3.5" A1 rectangle to the A2/E segment. This should measure 3.5" square
8. Make four Leaf Units.



Flower Petals

9. Fold each 2.5" x 3.5" A3 and C rectangle in half (WRONG sides together) so the short edges meet. This will give you a 2" x 1.75" folded rectangle.
10. Place a folded A3 rectangle on the top right corner of a 3.5" x 4.5" B rectangle (RST) so that the folded edge is facing the center. Repeat with folded C rectangle on the bottom right corner. Pin in place.
11. Place another 3.5" x 4.5" B rectangle, RST, on top and pin thru all layers. Stitch 1/4" seam.
12. Open layers to expose the folded rectangles inside. Using your fingers, spread the rectangle bottom edges from left to right forming a triangle. Press folded triangle edges.
13. From the wrong side, press seam open. You'll need to snip the folded edges inside the seam allowance to do this. It should measure 3.5" x 8.5".
14. Baste along the raw edges of the triangles.
15. Repeat to make four Flower Petal Units.



Block Assembly

16. Arrange Flower Center, Leaf Units and Petal Units as shown.
17. Sew units together into rows. Press as shown.
18. Sew rows together to form block. It should measure 14.5" square.
19. Optional: Add 2.5" borders to make a pillow cushion or wall hanging that measures 18.5".
