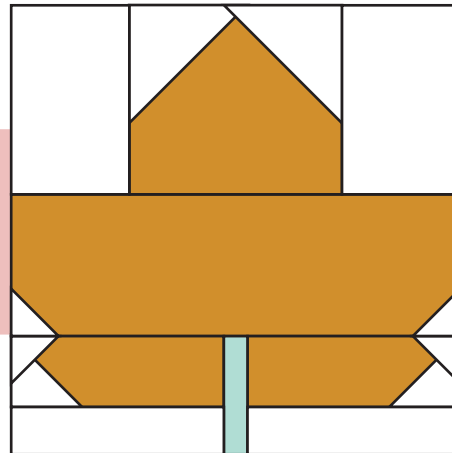


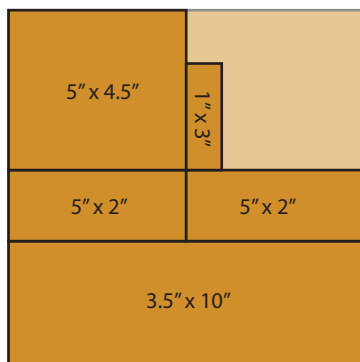

Falling Leaf

FINISHED BLOCK 9" X 9"



FABRIC CUTS

Background fabric supplied.

FROM EACH 10" SQUARE, CUT:

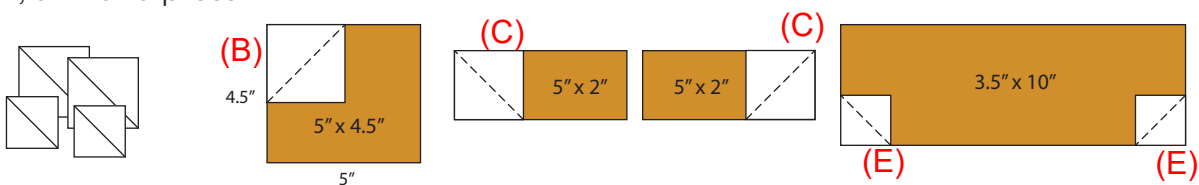
- (1) 3.5" X 10"
- (2) 2" X 5"
- (1) 5" X 4.5"
- (1) 1" X 3" (dark brown stem - supplied)

FROM BACKGROUND FABRIC:

- (2) @ 4.5" x 3" (A)
- (2) @ 3" X 3" (B)
- (2) @ 2" x 2" (C)
- (2) @ 1.5" x 5" (D),
- and (4) @ 1.5" x 1.5" (E)

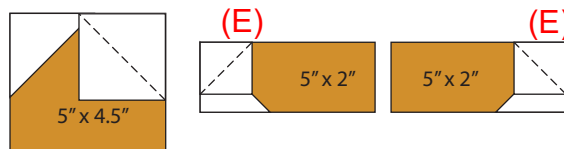
Use 1/4" seam allowance throughout

1. Gather all the background squares and all the print squares. Mark on the wrong side of background fabric squares along the diagonal. Snowball the corners of the main fabric pieces, as shown; trim and press.

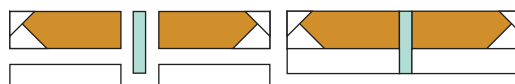


2. Gather 5" x 2" pieces and 5" x 4.5" piece, and snowball the corners one more time, as shown; trim and press.

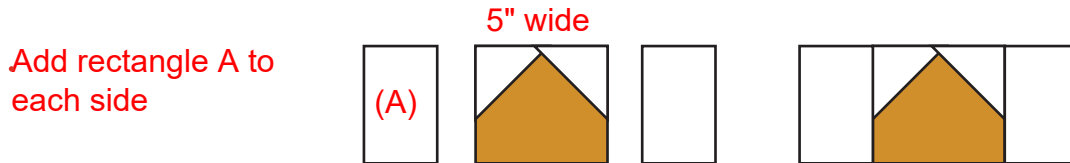
Add the second 3x3" square (B) to snowball the other corner



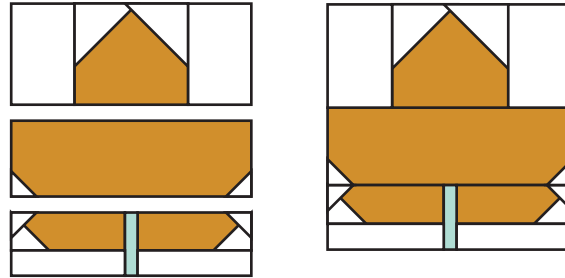
3. Gather together 2" x 5" background pieces, and 1" x 3" main fabric from a different print. Sew background strips to leaf sections on the bottom, and press toward background. Connect both leaf pieces to main fabric step piece, and press toward stem.



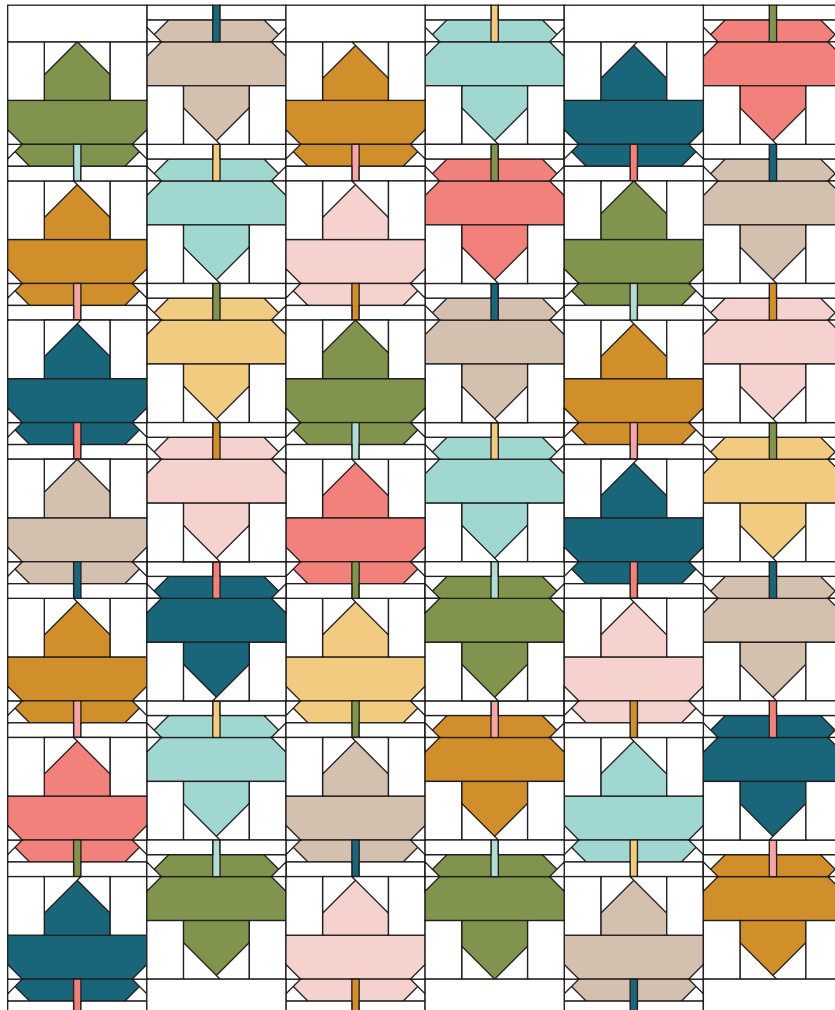
4. Gather remaining background and leaf top piece. Sew background pieces to sides of leaf piece and press toward background.



5. Sew top, middle, and bottom leaf sections together, and press toward center leaf section.



6. Arrange leaves into columns, offsetting each row by a 3" x 9.5" background strip. Sew, and press toward bottom leaf sections. Sew columns together, and press in one direction.



Quilt top measures 54" x 69"
