Pumpkin Block

Cutting Instructions

6 scrappy pumpkin color strips 2-1/2-inches x 10-1/2-inches

4 background squares 3-inches provided

2 background strips 2-1/2-inches x 5-1/2-inches provided

1 square 2-1/2-inches for the stem

Begin by sewing together the six pumpkin strips $2-1/2 \times 10-1/2$ along the long sides. If you have darker values, place those to the side with the lighter values in the center.

On the background squares, draw a diagonal line from one corner to the opposite corner. Place the squares on the corners of the pumpkin strips, with the line touching the edge of the pumpkin on both corners. Sew on the line and trim.

Sew a 2-1/2 x 5-1/2 background strip to each side of the stem square.

Sew the stem unit to the pumpkin unit.
