Scrappy Flag Quilt Block!



This block will be 8" once it is sewn into a project, or 8 1/2" alone. It can made up of scraps but would also look nice with just one red fabric and one cream fabric for all of the stripes. If you don't have a blue fabric with stars, substitute a dark blue/white print.

Step 1:

- From the blue fabric with stars, cut one 3 1/2" square.
- From the red scraps cut one strip 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" and two strips 1 1/2" x 6 1/2".
- From the cream scraps cut two strips 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" and one strip 1 1/2" x 6 1/2".
- From the background fabric cut two strips 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" and two strips 1 1/2" x 8 1/2". Supplied

Step 2:

Be sure to use a <u>1/4" seam</u> allowance.

- Sew the 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" strips together lengthwise, as shown in the photo.
- Sew the 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips together lengthwise, as shown in the photo.
- Press the seam allowances toward the red strips.





Step 3:

Sew the blue square to the end of the 3 1/2" strip set.

Press the seam allowances toward the blue square.




Step 4:

Sew the block/strip set to the 6 1/2" strip set.

Press the seam allowance toward the white strip.

Sew the 6 1/2" borders to the sides of the block.

Press the seam allowance toward the border strips.



Step 5:

Sew the 8 1/2" border strips to the top and bottom of the block.

Press the seam allowances toward the border strips.

The block will measure 8 1/2" square.
